Graduation Application Overview

How does the approval process start?

Graduation application starts with communication between the student and the Professional Academic Adviser. The student's Program Evaluation should be reviewed and additional requirements not listed on the Program Evaluation should be discussed. Students should register for their remaining classes to ensure their Program Evaluation has a status of 'Pending Anticipated Complete'.

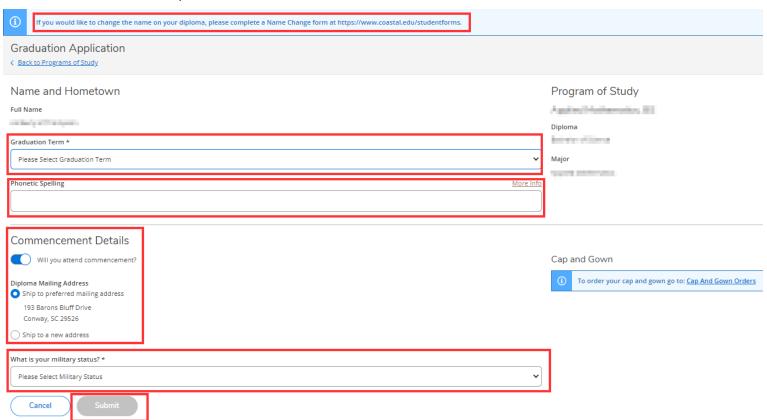
<u>Tip:</u> Students transferring in remaining coursework will not have a 'Pending Anticipated Complete Status'. Check with your professional adviser if you have any questions.

Where do I apply for graduation?

After this advisement session is completed, the student is ready to apply online through <u>Self Service</u> <u>https://sservice.coastal.edu/Student/Student/Graduation</u>. Students will see an **Apply** link.

Students will receive an email acknowledgment to their CCU email address within 5 minutes of applying with all active academic advisers copied on the email.

Next, your application will move through departmental and college level reviews and end up with the Registrar's Office. Your application will then remain at that status until after final grades have been received for the semester, at which time a final audit will be conducted by the Registrar's Office to ensure you have met all of your degree requirements. Depending on the number of graduation candidates, the final audit process can take up to six to eight weeks to be completed.

How do I pay my graduation application fee?

Students will receive a link in their acknowledgement email to the <u>Student Account Center</u> to make a payment for their graduation application.

Students that are **reapplying for the same program** (e.g. from previous denial or any other reason) will not be required to repay the application fee (the payment section of the online application will be bypassed). However, students will need to pay and apply for each separate degree.
