Documentation in your letter dated May 16, 2022, noted no new students were admitted to the program, effective summer 2021, and the notification of termination to the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education noted the program would be closed to new students in December 2021. When an institution closes a program or instructional site, it has an affirmative obligation to seek closure approval from SACSCOC at the time the closure decision is made and prior to the cessation of instruction. The closure date is the date students are no longer admitted.

There are no students currently enrolled in the program. As noted on the teach-out plan, faculty advisors in the Department of Music will work with prospective music education students, directing them to the Bachelor of Music Education program.

Closure of the program was initiated by faculty in the Master of Arts in Teaching and the Department of Music following discussion and analysis. No faculty or staff will be negatively impacted as a result of the closure.

The Board of Trustees of the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges approves the late closure of the Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT) with a concentration in Music (K-12).

This letter serves as a notification that Coastal Carolina University received approval from the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education to terminate the Master of Arts in Teaching (M.A.T) with a concentration in Music (K-12) degree effective December 2021.

The M.A.T. in Music (K-12) required students to complete 12-16 credit hours in the following areas of studies for the concentration: Music Education, Choral or Instrumental Conducting, Methods, Principles and Methods of Teaching Music, World Music and Independent Music Study.

Due to no enrollments in the program, it was recommended by the faculty and administration that the program be closed.

With the approval of this termination, the program will be closed. Currently there are no students enrolled in the program and no new applications are being accepted. The teach-out plan is attached along with a copy of the curriculum for the M.A.T. in Music (K-12) concentration.
