For most CLEP exams, scores are presented on screen immediately upon completion of the exam. If testing in person, students may leave with an unofficial score report.

## SCORE REPORTS

# College Level Examination Program

Enrolled, degree-seeking students at Coastal Carolina University can earn college credit for knowledge gained outside the classroom. The College Level Examination Program (CLEP) is a system of credit by examination sponsored by the College Board. The examinations are developed by college faculty nationwide and reflect material usually covered during basic or introductory coursework.

The tests are fair but demanding. Through this program, degree candidates at Coastal Carolina University may attempt a CLEP test on subjects listed within this brochure. A satisfactory score will give the student credit equal to the comparable college course. Some examinations may not be accepted for required or elective courses. Students should check with their advisor before attempting exams.

Please read the following information before scheduling a CLEP examination:

- Students must be currently enrolled in classes at Coastal Carolina University.
- Credit is not awarded for CLEP General Examinations.
- There is a fee for taking a CLEP Subject Examination; this fee is non-refundable.
- CLEP credit will only be posted after the Office of the Registrar has received the official score report from Educational Testing Service.
- CLEP scores are not calculated into the student's GPA; students receive credit hours only.
- CLEP credit will not be awarded if students are on suspension (academic or nonacademic) from the University.
- CLEP scores do not transfer to other institutions unless the student requests an official transcript from CLEP (for a fee) by [visiting clep.collegeboard.org](http://visiting.clep.collegeboard.org) or calling **800-257-9558**. Acceptance is up to the individual university.

Subject examinations are administered at Coastal Carolina University. General CLEP exams are not offered and are not accepted for credit. Each examination is in multiple-choice format and is 90 minutes in duration.
